- Coordinate, manage and supervise execution of field subcontracted construction activities for bulk material storage and handling facilities and slip form concrete projects in agricultural and heavy industrial markets.
- Supervise and coordinate subcontractors and field personnel in daily construction activities
- Interpret project drawings and documents for subcontractors and field personnel
- Supervise Field Clerk (if applicable)
- Communicate with Owners' representative and Project Manager with regard to project schedules, milestone progress, scope of work and other project related items
- Communicate with office-based Project Managers, Engineers, Project Drafting Leaders, purchasing and accounting groups regarding field construction project requirements
- Coordinate mobilization and delivery schedules with vendors, subcontractors, Project Manager, purchasing group and Owner
- Maintain company owned tools and storage facilities
- Coordinate and supervise slip form activities
- Manage equipment and material receiving activities including supervision of unloading trucks, receiving report documentation, coordination and documentation of job site storage locations
- Coordinate plant start up activities and execution of project schedules

- Monitor and control field costs with regards to hours worked, field purchasing, rental equipment use and subcontractor activities
